
Uptown Circulator



Uptown Circulator

- Public-Private transportation project
- Connects Uptown's major employment, medical and education centers
- Proposed in the 2017 Uptown Master Mobility Plan
- Launch delayed and private funding for first year returned to partners in 2020
- Public dollars are committed. Recommitment from private (Moffitt, AdventHealth, USF, and RD Management, LLC needed to proceed
- MOU between Tampa !p and HART will be needed to restart implementation







Uptown Circulator

- 2017 Mobility Master Plan
- Connects Medical and Educational Centers, Regional Activity Centers and Jobs
- Serves UATC Transit Center
- Adds to Ridership Reported to National Transit Database

Uptown Circulator Initial Service

- Focus on Core Area
- Days of Service Monday through Friday
- Service Span 7 AM to 10 PM
- Frequency
 - Every 15 Minutes/Peak
 - Every 30 Minutes/Off Peak
- Vehicle Requirement 4 Daily
- Route Length 12 Miles
- Annual Cost \$785,000

Uptown Circulator Long Term Service

- Expanded Service Area
- Days of Service Monday through Friday
- Service Span 7 AM to 10 PM
- Frequency Every 15 Minutes/All Day
- Vehicle Requirement 5 Daily
- Route Length 14.5 Miles
- Annual Service Hours 17,700
- Annual Cost \$1,330,000
